## Letter and Message to the participant of the General Assembly of the Focolare Movement

Their reward awaits each and every one of them in heaven. In the midst of this, I have learned a great lesson from them; that of LIVING TOGETHER AS A FAMILY. They are indeed a true trustworthy family. They haven't given up on us and I pray they don't give up on us. The Focolare Movement is

like the back bone of Fontem, without which we are nothing.

My plight to you today and to all members at this General Assembly is that you people should channel our problems to our father in Heaven through the Blessed Virgin Mary our mother. Please use your good office as you have always done to call on the entire Focolare movement in the world to pray for Fontem in particular and for Cameroon as a whole so that peace can return to our country. It is our greatest desire to live the words of Mama Chiara "MAY ALL BE ONE". Remember us in your prayers because prayers is all we need now. Man has failed but God cannot fail.

May the Holy Mother Mary bless you all and see you all through your deliberations during this very important General Assembly.
